#### NOTES:

1. On arrival at the venue, choirs will register and children will be issued with a security band
2. Choir Leaders will be issued with an ID tag which must be returned at the end of the night.
3. Please bring a choir register with you for health and safety purposes. This need only be a first name (an initial for surname should you have more than one choir member with the same forename)
4. Children will leave their coats and bags in the Avon room during both the rehearsal time and the show
5. Children can eat their packed tea in the Avon Room
6. The venue does **NOT** allow hot food to be consumed in the building
7. Please try to keep bags to a minimum and keep a clear walkway
8. Children must always be accompanied to and from the toilets – this includes the downstairs toilets as last year some children decided to block the sinks with toilet paper and caused a flood
9. Please bring a copy of your backing track with you on the night in case of any technical issues
10. Please send us the names of your chaperones in advance as we need to give a copy to the venues for H&S purposes Our chaperone ratio is 1:10 unless otherwise agreed
11. Remember Glitter is **NOT** allowed in the theatre.
