4. Children will leave their coats and bags in the Marryat Hall during both the rehearsal time and the show
5. Children can eat their packed tea in the Marryat Hall. If food is taken into the auditorium, please make sure any rubbish is cleared away.
7. Please try to keep bags to a minimum and keep a clear walkway
8. Chaperones should be seated amongst the choir rather than all together.
6. Children must always be accompanied to and from the toilets as we do not have exclusive use of the toilets and they can be accessed by the public
9. Please bring a copy of your backing track with you on the night in case of any technical issues
10. Please send us the names of your chaperones in advance as we need to give a copy to the venues for H&S purposes Our chaperone ratio is 1:10 unless otherwise agreed
11. Remember Glitter is **NOT** allowed in the theatre.
