NOTES:

1. On arrival at the venue, choirs will register and children will be issued with a security band.
2. Choir Leaders will be issued with an ID tag which must be returned at the end of the night.
3. Please bring a choir register with you for health and safety purposes. This need only be a first name (an initial for surname should you have more than one choir member with the same forename)
4. Please try to keep bags to a minimum and keep a clear walkway. Children will keep their coats and bags with them in the auditorium. These should be tucked under their seats for safety
5. Children may eat their packed tea in the auditorium. Please make sure any rubbish is cleared away.
6. We do not encourage the use of props/placards, however, if you do bring these with you please make sure that they are not too big as there is no storage area in the auditorium
7. Chaperones should be seated amongst the choir rather than all together.
8. Children must always be accompanied to and from the toilets as we do not have exclusive use of the toilets and they can be accessed by the public
9. Please bring a copy of your backing track with you on the night in case of any technical issues
10. Please send us the names of your chaperones in advance as we need to give a copy to the venues for H&S purposes Our chaperone ratio is 1:10 unless otherwise agreed
11. Remember Glitter is NOT allowed in any theatre.
